About dtw Research, Inc.

dtw Research, Inc. (“dtw” or “we”, “us” or “our”) is a pharmaceutical marketing and industry specific resource company. Our customers and visitors to our website (the “Site”) are generally owners, employees and/or consultants of or to pharmaceutical companies, marketing research companies, advertising and public relation companies. **Our products, services and our Site are not intended for individuals for their personal use.** Further, access to certain secured areas of our Site are restricted to persons working for or employed by companies that have an agreement with dtw, whether by having either purchased a subscription, having a free trial or a free account, or otherwise having been granted access to our proprietary database (collectively defined as an “Agreement”), or placed orders with us to receive access to other products and services through our Site for the subject company’s business needs. Types of Private Information

dtw recognizes three types of private information.

- **Contact Information:** includes your name, your company name, your company address, company telephone number, company email address, or other limited personally-identifiable information. We also store an encrypted version of the password you select to access the dtw Database. Our Site and products/services are intended for use by corporate entities and other businesses. **We do NOT knowingly gather personal telephone numbers, home address or other**

similar information. **PLEASE DO NOT PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION TO DTW.** Please see our Terms of Use [www.dtwresearch.com/terms/] for important information about access credentials.

- **Agreement Information:** includes your preferences for e-Alerts, online surveys, CDP: WorldWide login information, PMRD reports, and similar items related to the content provided to you by dtw.
- **Transactional Information:** includes all information relating to the purchasing of goods and services from dtw or a Third Party Provider, e.g., a credit card number or order confirmation number. **You should only use corporate account information for purchases of goods and services through our Site. Please do not to use your personal account information.**
- **Non-personally identifiable information.** We collect non-personally-identifiable information from you through our Site, which we track and store, such as the use of the Site and our products offered thereon, when and how many times you and other persons from your company use, access or download information from and/or through our Site.

How dtw Collects Private Information

We assume no liability for your company's disclosure to us of your name, company email and/or company telephone number.**

We may use 'cookies' to enhance your online experience with the dtw. A 'cookie' is a small file that your Web browser will place on your hard drive or device. It allows us to remember you and keep track of your preferences and access credentials. Use of cookies allows us to deliver content specific to your interests and to save your access credentials so you don't have to re-enter it each time you visit our Site. Who Collects, Processes, Stores, or Views Your Information

We use third party providers to process online credit card payments for our products and services. We do not store any credit card information on the Site or through our products and services. Sharing of Information

Other than as set forth in this Privacy Policy, dtw does not share, rent or sell any personally-identifiable information that we collect from you with any third parties.

dtw may share or disclose non-personally identifiable information with third parties.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

Promotional Offers from dtw.
